*The child is interacting with their adult.

*The child is learning to copy the adult

*The child will begin to say some words.

*Repeating rhymes develops memory.

*Singing rhymes develops language.

*Playing instruments develops rhythm.

*Meeting others develops social skills.

*Eventually the child will benefit at nursery and school as rhyming is a very important skill when learning to read.
